







Information on getting around the city of Graz, reaching the university campus and the conference venue.

The conference venue is at the <u>Institute for English Studies</u> (Heinrichstraße 36)

There will be signs all over the university campus to facilitate your way to the conference venue.

To get from the Airport of Graz to the main train station in Graz:

Welcome to the University of Graz!

If you are staying near the main train station (Graz Hauptbahnhof), then you simply take the bus nr 58 at the main train station (direction Ragnitz) You then get off at the bus stop "Uni/Mozartgasse" which is right next to the conference venue.

You can also take bus nr 63, (direction Schulzentrum St. Peter) which leaves from the main train station. You need to get off either at the bus stop "Attemsgasse" or "Universität Graz", in front of the main university building. The conference venue is on the left side of the main university building, within 5 minutes of walking distance from either one of these two bus stops.

If you are staying near the area of Andritz, <u>bus nr 41</u> (Direction St. Leonhard) is also a great option to take you to the campus. The bus stops "Attemsgasse" or "Universität Graz" are each within 5 minutes walking distance from the conference venue.

From Jakominiplatz, you can take the bus nr 31 (Direction ResoWi) that takes you directly to the university campus. You need to get off at the last bus stop "Uni Resowi", which is on campus and within short walking distance from the conference venue. From that stop, you walk towards the main campus, keeping on the right of the main university building.





From the main train station or the areas of Mariatrost, Liebenau or Eggenberg, you can also take the trams: Linie 1, Linie 4, Linie 6, or Linie 7, change at Jakominiplatz, and then take the <u>bus nr 31</u> that takes you directly to the university campus.

If you are staying near the areas of Andritz, Puntigam or Krenngasse, you can also take trams Linie 3 or Linie 5, change in Jakominiplatz and take bus nr 31 to the university campus.

If you get the tickets from any of the shops or the ticket machines around the city, you need to validate it once you get on the bus, or the tram. If you get the ticket from the machines inside of the tram, the ticket will be already validated for you. You need the follow the same steps whether it is an hour ticket, 24-hours ticket, 48-hours or 72-hours ticket. If you get the tickets online via the app, you will get it 10% cheaper than the usual price. And remember, that with this same public transport ticket, you can also use the Schlossberg Funicular for free, which will take you on top of Schlossberg and enjoy a great view of the entire city of Graz. The Schlossberg funicular is reachable within walking distance from the main city centers (Jakominiplatz, Kunsthaus or Hauptplatz). With tram nr 3 or 5 (Direction Andritz), you stop at Schlossbergbahn and the walk towards the funicular.
